### DYLAN COLLINS

Mr. Timothy Dylan Collins, 35, of Villa Rica, Georgia passed away Friday, September 11, 2015 after a two-year battle with cholangiocarcinoma, a very aggressive bile duct (liver) cancer. He was born April 16, 1980 in Cincinnati, Ohio the son of Mr. Tim Collins and Mrs. Cyndie Collins. Dylan was a Christian who loved the Lord with all of his heart. He had a compassion for other people and was a very kind person. He loved hosting trivia at Fabiano's for over 10 years, and also created an online singing and voice acting community that launched several careers. He also hosted several podcasts that had a huge following. An accomplished musician/singer/songwriter, he enjoyed being around his family and pets, playing video games, and traveling, especially to Disney. He faced everything with bravery and an unbelievable attitude. On more than one occasion he said that he felt like maybe the reason he had this cancer was to bring people together that had damaged relationships, or to bring people closer to God. He succeeded in doing that. He managed to find those people who needed a friend the most, pulled them out of the darkness and showed them a side of themselves they might not have ever known otherwise.

He is survived by his parents, Tim and Cyndie Collins of Villa Rica; two brothers and a sister-in-law, Adam and Christina Collins of Cleveland, TN and Jesse Collins of Villa Rica; and his loving, faithful dog, Morris Day.

The family will receive friends at Jones-Wynn Funeral Home, 2189 Midway Road in Douglasville on Sunday October 4, 2015 from 2-3 PM. A Memorial Service will be conducted Sunday, October 4, 2015 at 3:00 PM at the Chapel of Jones-Wynn Funeral Home in Douglasville with Joe Keith officiating.
