No sooner had he dropped exhausted into bed, when his little children woke him to go with them to the backyard to see if Santa had indeed delivered the coveted gift. Excitedly getting out of bed, he hurried to the back yard and exuberantly pushed his children on the swings and gliders and caught them at the end of the slide. What a man!

He was a member of Arbor Heights Bible Church in Douglasville, and previously was a member of the Villa Rica First United Methodist Church He served as a Spec 4th. Class in the United States Army in the 11th Airborne Division. He retired from Sears as the Manager of the Receiving and Distribution Center in Ft. Lauderdale, FL with over 35 years of employment. Many years were also devoted to Junior Achievement.

After moving to Carrollton in 1989, he worked with the Post Office in Villa Rica as a substitute rural carrier for a number of years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Elaine Mae Kershner Dwyer; infant twins, Deborah Ann Dwyer and Keith Allan Dwyer; brother, Robert William Dwyer; sister and brother-in-law, Martyne Ruth and Rei Jokela.
