I lived in Doughtsville at the time.I was so embarrassed, Termite,would smirk just laughed it off, and we went on our date. I had moved from Villa Rica,and was going to start school there in Douglasville. My Daddy was teasing him for sure. I was crazy in love with him.Kinda like my first love.We went to some High hillside land, my Father had owned. (I believe it is a golf course now). We would just shoot the breeze,laugh,and listen to music,from his radio, and drink from Dixie cups. (Booms Farm Strawberry Hill Wine)Look at the Stars, Oh those were the fun days.He was so kind and respectable.I remember we spoke of our lives ahead and he wanted to be a Carpenter, or join the Army. I was going to be a Photographer. I know I moved away from my Dad's, My parents were divorced. I was young about 16.
